

Barbados

Not quite a hotel, more than a bed & breakfast but a beautiful rambling mansion. All rooms have A/C. Breakfast, light lunch and afternoon tea daily. **Barbados** is an island country in the Lesser Antilles. It is 21 miles in length and as much as 14 miles in width, amounting to 166 sq miles. Crystal clear waters, all year round diving, great reef diving, exotic sea-life and numerous shipwrecks to explore. With unbeatable underwater visibility of 70 to 80 feet with annual water temperatures of 80 degrees. Barbados is situated in the western area of the North Atlantic and 62 miles east of the Windward Islands and the Caribbean Sea. Walk out of the Inn and hop on to the dive boat. The barrier reefs, located 1/2 - 2 miles from shore contain large coral heads which form the habitat for thousands of beautiful fish and are perfect for snorkeling. Larger critters are also found on these reefs, feeding on the smaller fish. The **SS Stavronikita** is a 365ft Greek freighter that was deliberately sunk to form an artificial reef, this wreck is now home to numerous fish and corals. The Stavronikita lies in 120ft of water with the stern at 100ft and the bow at 70ft.
