“The Graveyard of the Atlantic gets its name for the estimated 2000 shipwrecks scattered along the North Carolina Coastline. Some of the impressive wrecks are the World War II casualties—vessels fallen prey to Hitler’s U-boat fleet. Tankers, cargo ships, German submarines, and a World War 1 gunboat are just a few of the historical wrecks you can see.

- **100 cubic foot tank with 30% Nitrox for all dives. (pony cylinders available at additional cost)**

- **Advanced Open Water certification with deep diving required (all dives will be 90 - 120 feet deep).**
- **Box lunch available for added cost of \$11 a day.**
